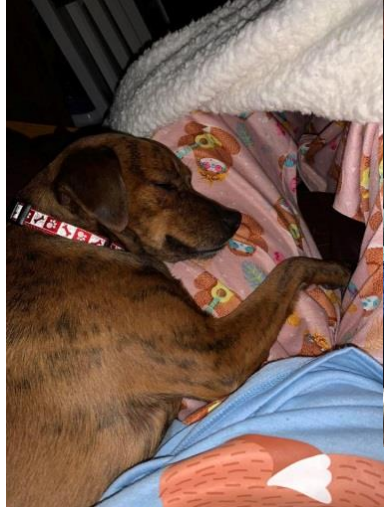


# PUPP NEWSLETTER

They say Lexi is doing great ! A little stubborn (lol), but still doing her commands and is much improved!! They thank everybody involved in helping her!



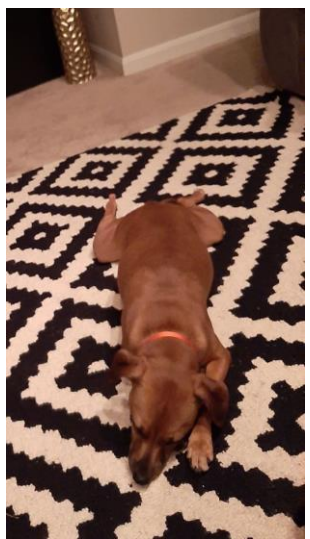
Utah is waving bye to his foster home.



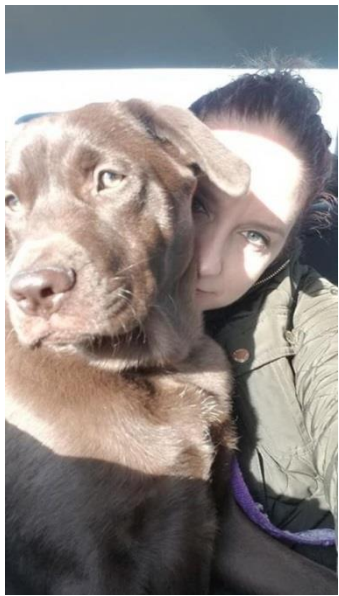
Dizzy walking with his new sister.
