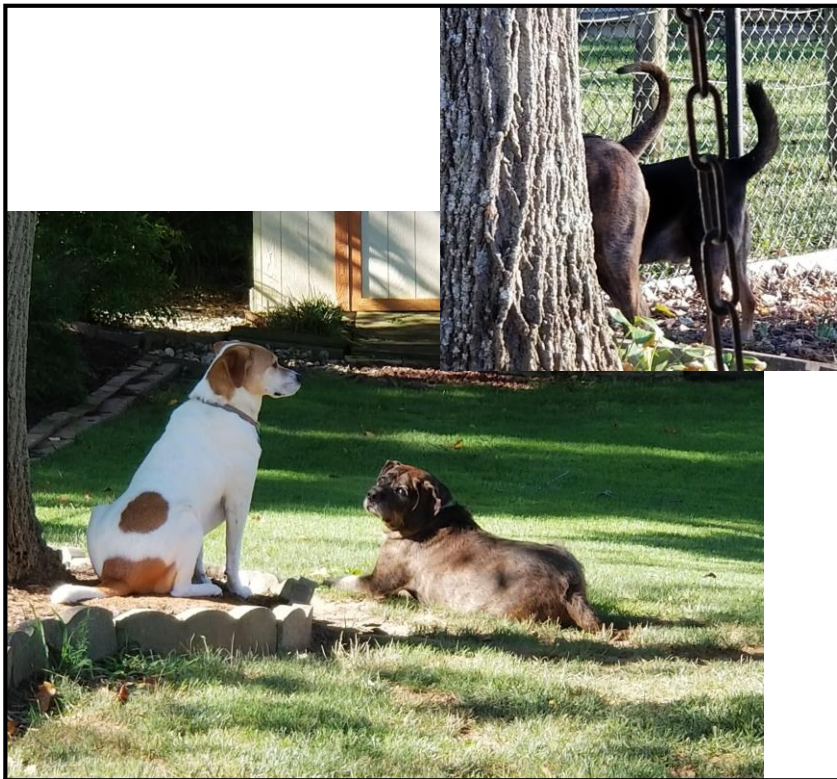

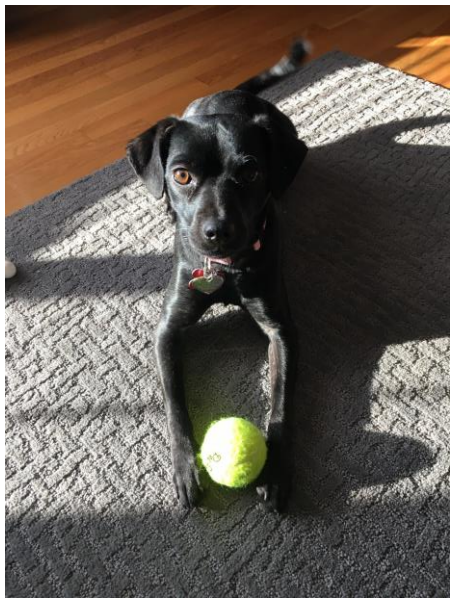

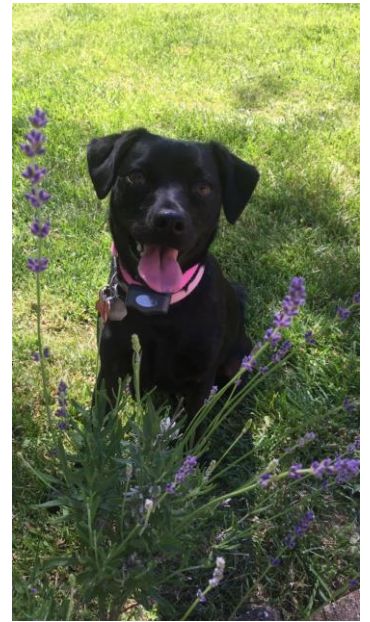
Tana and Basil got paroled but now they are apparently back in jail?! (No idea why the sidewalk says that! Lol)
