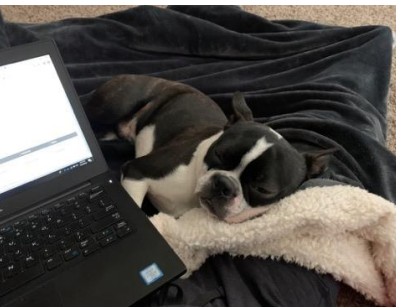
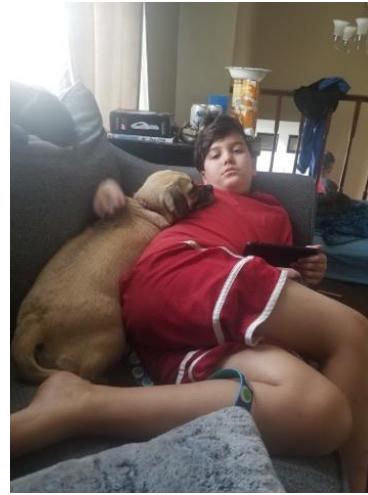


November 2019
