

"CZ graduated from the PUPP Program in 2011. I also had Fletcher too, CZ's brother, but he passed away in 2017."




"Here's Zeke in his Turkey tie after a recent grooming. We love our sweet boy!"



It has been a struggle but she now goes to adults and children, thinks everyone should pet her. Will go up to any size dog, doesn't play, she doesn't know how too. She has a quiet spirit, perfect for an 80 year old woman. When she came here she could barely walk 15 minutes, at the end of last summer, she was up to 45. It hasn't been easy, but it has been worthwhile. Thank You for the job you are doing finding homes for dogs like DeSiree.

Hank is still in a foster home, but he's doing okay. He makes progress every week and we're hopeful a patient adopter will turn up soon.
