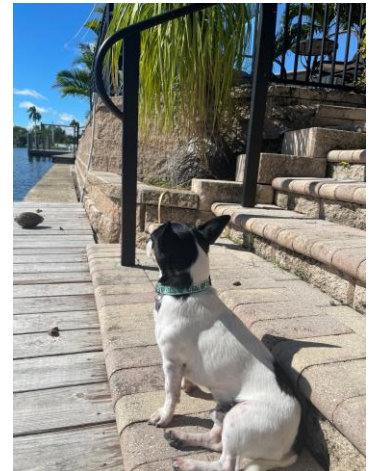

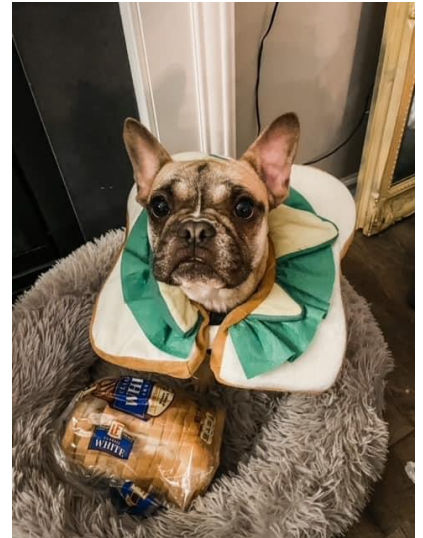

Finn is still doing so well with his new mom and they see his brother Barkley occasionally for play dates!

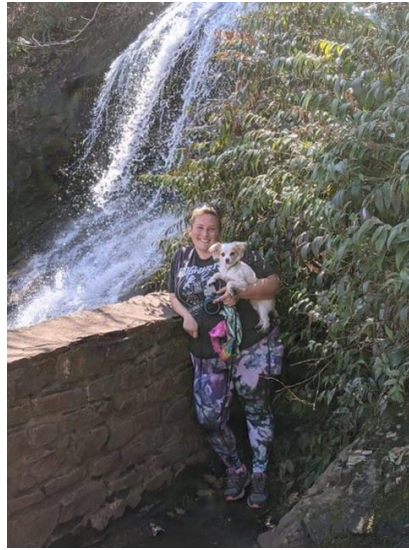
