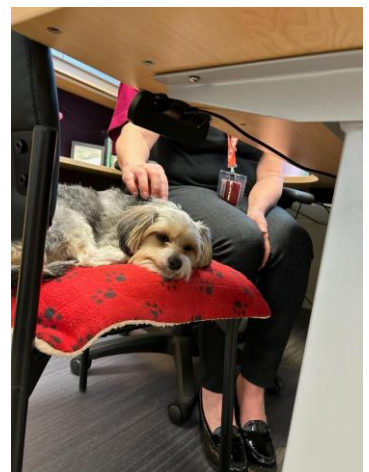

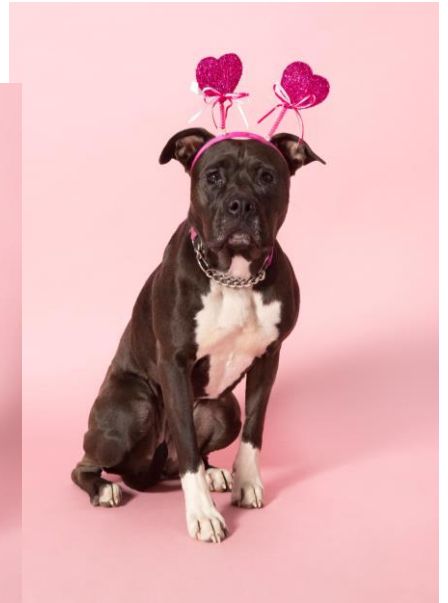

Jared loves his new mom and gets to go to work with her everyday! We think the feeling is mutual!



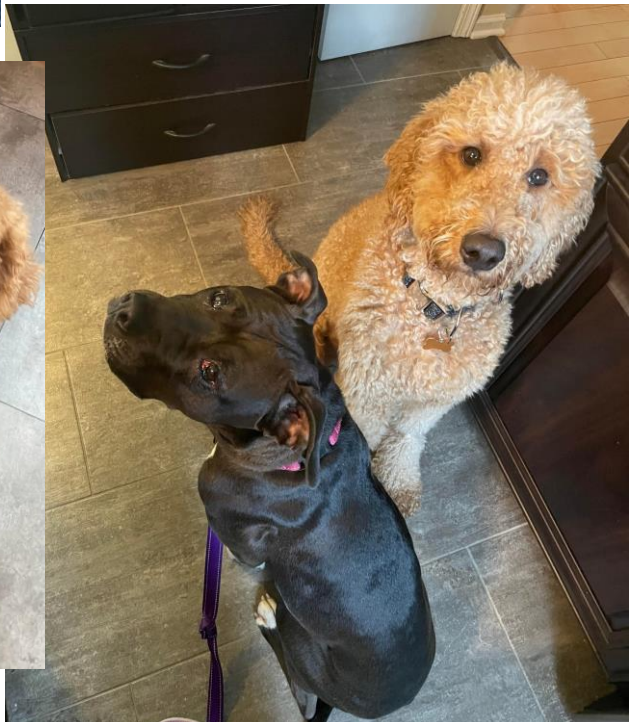


“Cricket on her little past one-year anniversary of being adopted. This is her on the right from the picture I got today and the picture on the left is when I got first got her to foster!!!”



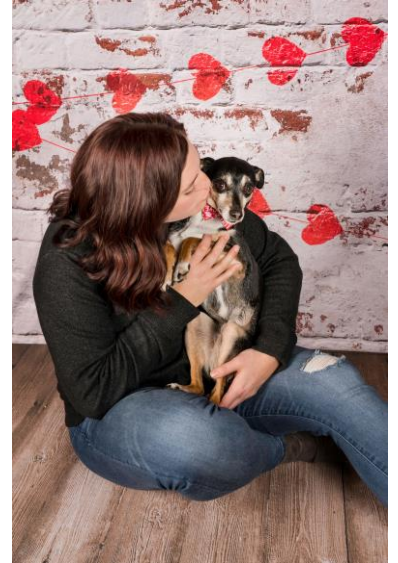

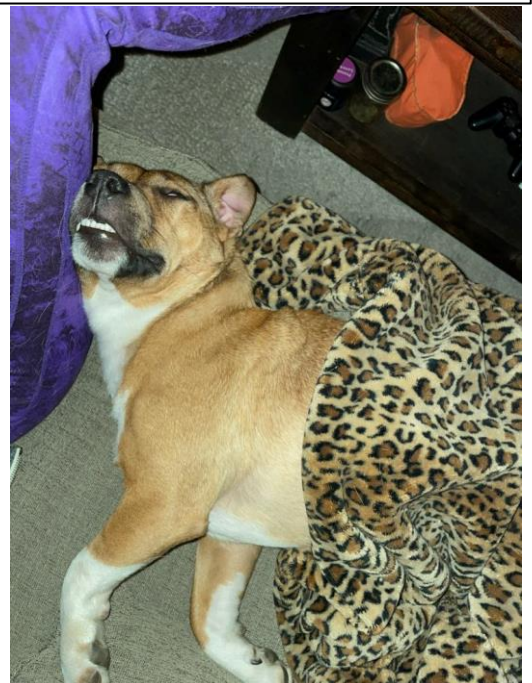
Bane and Moby were thick as thieves until Moby went to prison for training. Bane is still doing well in his foster home and we hope he gets adopted soon!

Mason's family adores him and said he's fitting right in with his human and pug siblings! He'll have his teeth cleaned soon too!



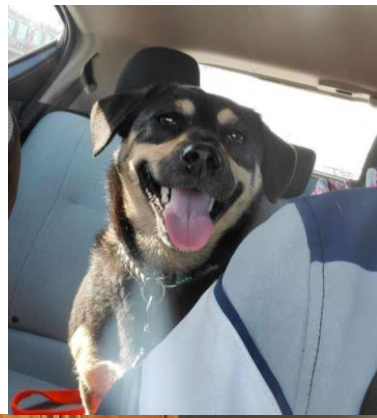

“Ivy is doing great! She loves running around the yard and her grandparents buy her so many toys. She’s spoiled already!”



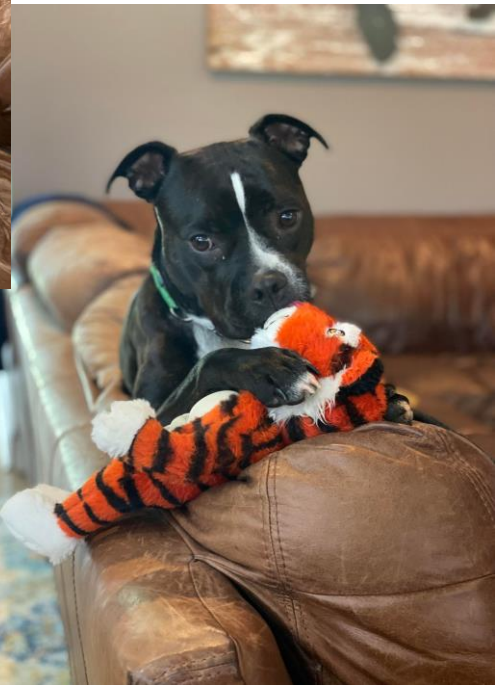
