



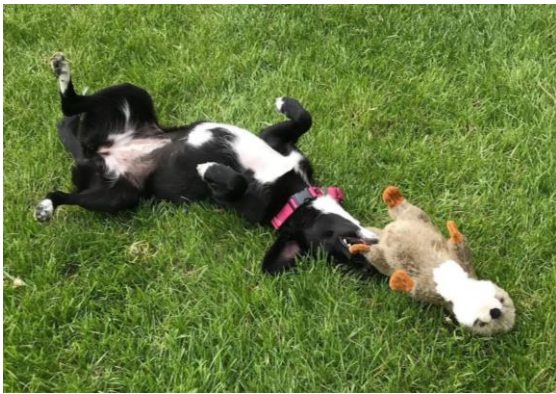
PUPP NEWSLETTER

Keep up the great work!



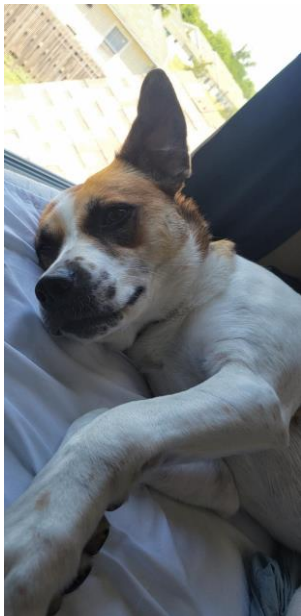
"Dolly is a welcomed addition to our family! The kids, and even the cat (sometimes), love to play with her!!"

The airplane pillow was when he kept going under the fence. He got tired of patching holes and decided to make him bigger. It worked for a while. LOL”



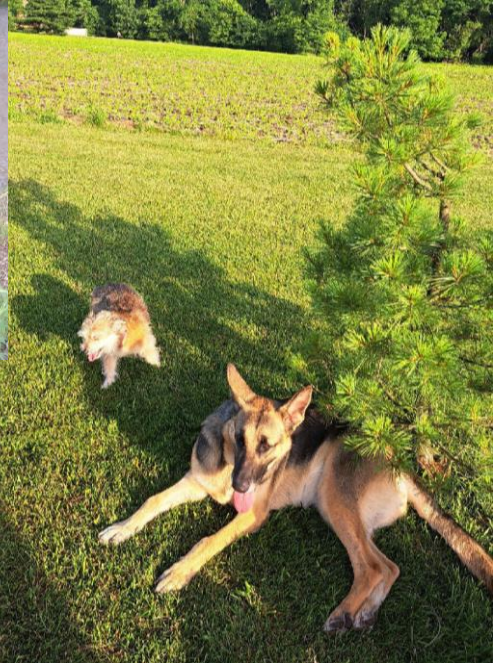
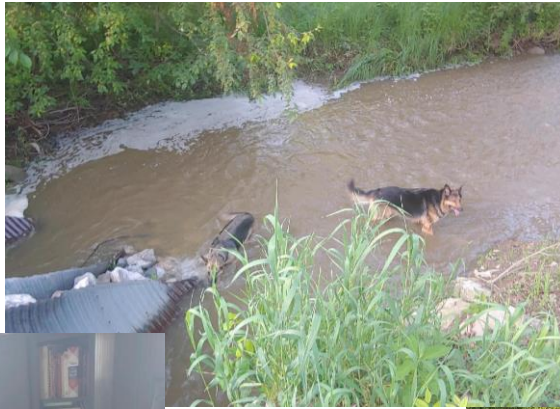

Zoey loves her new canine siblings and is fitting right in at home! She goes on long hikes every week and has a lot of time in the water in the creek behind her house!



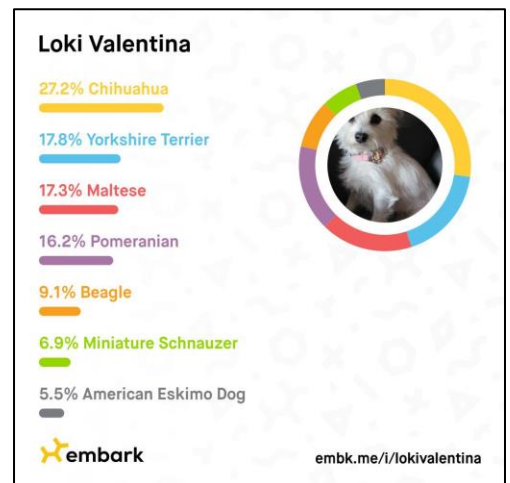
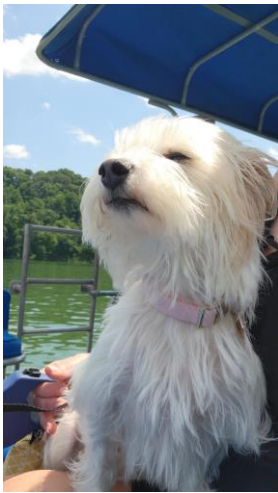

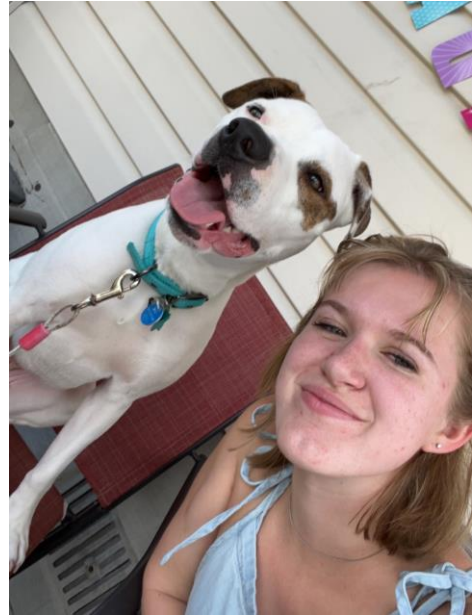

Coby is Coby, and hopefully his new owners will follow our training advice, so he can thrive in his new home! Only time will tell!



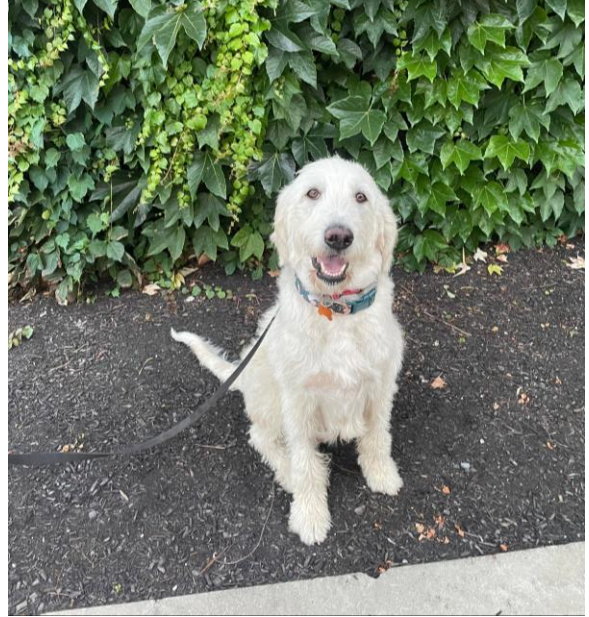
